He knew about the sudden storms which can come out of nowhere. There's so much more in his story and we look forward to unpacking this further with our different devotional speakers.

#### **Plenary speakers:**

Married couple Rev Dr Rob Hay and Sarah Hay will explore what it looks like to live, minister, lead and provide member care in a complex world. Complexity theory has not been applied to member care... until now. What postures and practices can we utilise, such as sensemaking and tentative certainty, to strengthen our own resilience and skills? How does it impact our member care strategy and provision?

#### **Workshops:**

We will be offering a wide range of workshops, some of which will be a 2-day track. We have some gifted, experienced speakers looking at issues such as: supporting people during seasons of emotional and physical exhaustion; how we as practitioners navigate through conflict, isolation, trauma and grief; what a theology of risk looks like, how we think about making decisions during risk, and how we help others manage fear and display courage.

We will also have a workshop track **specifically for professional counsellors, psychologists and mental health workers**, considering how to provide psychological assistance to broken relationships between adult TCKs and their mission parents.
